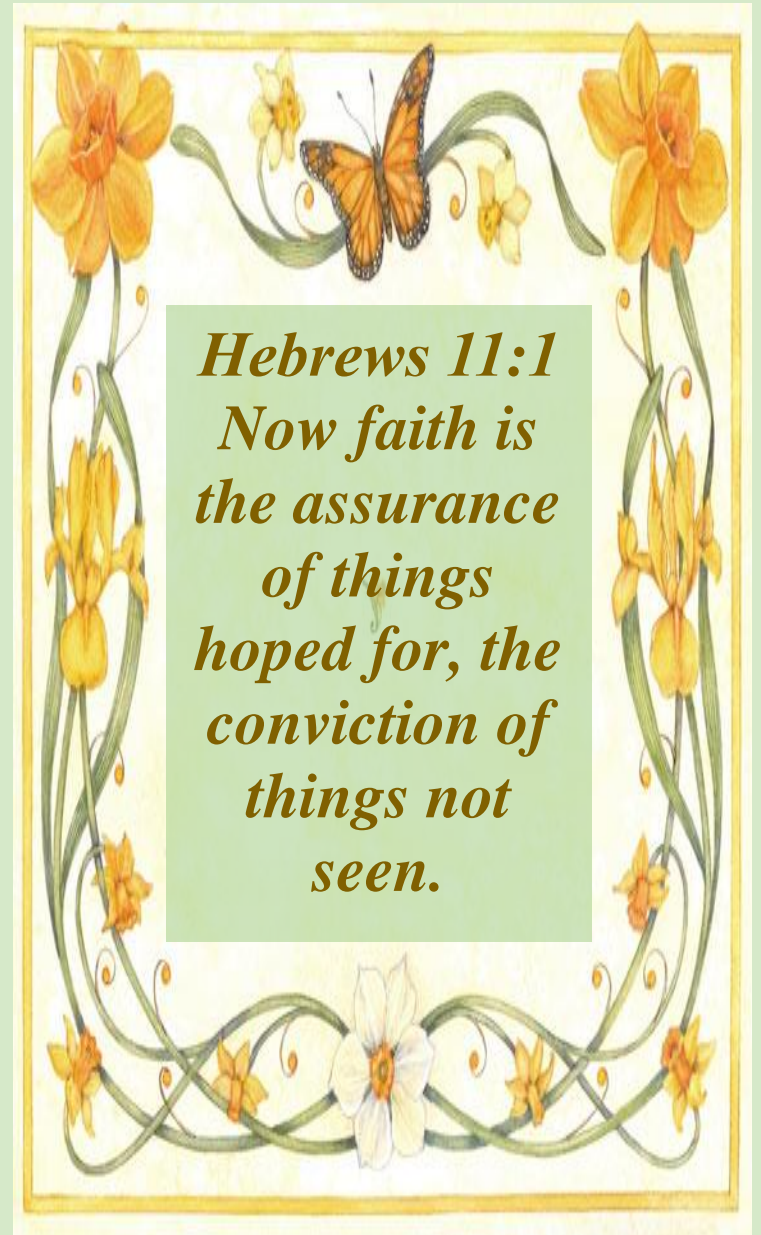

However, our church practices and accepts only the baptism of
the New Testament, which is immersion for the remission of sins.
(Colossians 2:12, 13) If you have not been immersed you can
anticipate experiencing this God ordained ordinance.
