You may be a first-time visitor, but you're not a stranger. The Visitor's Package has been developed to let you know you're important to us. Our fellowship has been made richer because you are here.

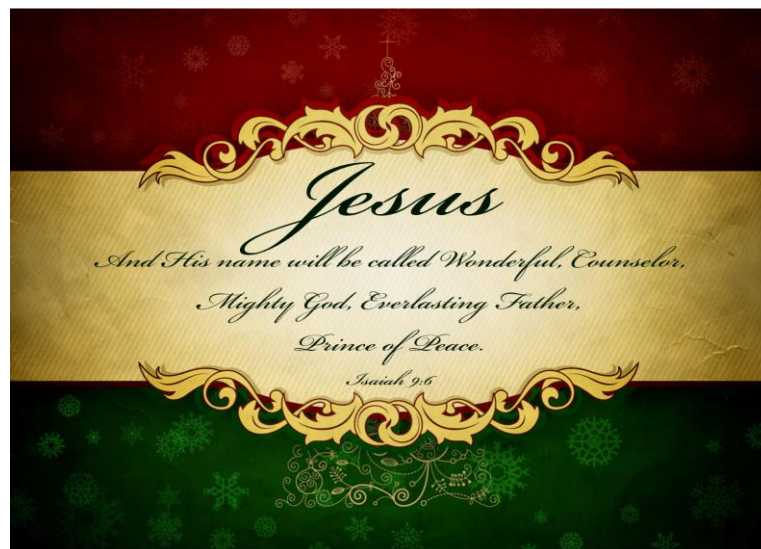
Please fill out the visitor's card enclosed in the package and drop it in the offering plate or hand it to the Minister on your way out. We want to get to know you better!

If you are a member of a church elsewhere, and wish to become a part of our Church family, you need no church letter of transfer. However, our church practices and accepts only the baptism of the New Testament, which is immersion for the remission of sins. (Colossians 2:12, 13) If you have not been immersed you can anticipate experiencing this God ordained ordinance.
