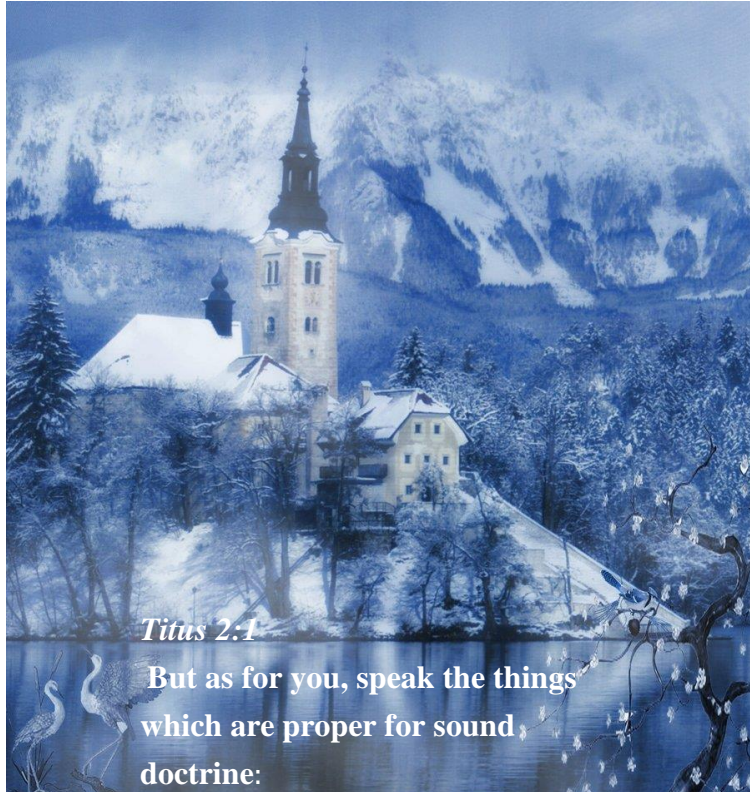




## Visitors...

(Colossians 2:12, 13) If you have not been immersed you can  
anticipate experiencing this God ordained ordinance.
