

At the close of each service we give the opportunity for those desiring to become a Christian to step out and come forward. You will be given the opportunity to confess that Jesus is the Christ the Son of the living God and to Repent and to be Baptized for the remission of sins as seen in Acts 2:38. However, our church practices and accepts only the baptism of the New Testament, which is immersion for the remission of sins. (Colossians 2:12, 13) If you have not been immersed you can anticipate experiencing this God ordained ordinance.
