### SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP SERVICE AT THE CHURCH BUILDING

In keeping with CDC and state of VA guidelines
Things to know before the service:

1: Six-foot rule

(Individuals must maintain 6-foot distancing and seating 6 foot apart. Families may be seated together)

2: No Physical contact

3: No passing out of – bulletins, communion, offering plate, etc.

(Hand Sanitizer is available near entrance/exit doors)
5: Nursery will be available for parents use only for changing and feeding.
