Heath Calhoun has a long road to recovery ahead. Please remember Heath in your prayers and send him a card of encouragement. His address is:



If you are a member of a church elsewhere and wish to become a part of our Church family, you need no church letter of transfer. However, our church practices and accepts only the baptism of the New Testament, which is immersion for the remission of sins. (Colossians 2:12, 13) If you have not been immersed you can anticipate experiencing this God ordained ordinance.
